

BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN

ORDINANCE NO. 2153-14

ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 7-2 CLOSING OF STREETS AND ESTABLISH SUB-SECTION 7-2.3 OF CHAPTER 7 (TRAFFIC) OF THE BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE RIDDLE WAY FROM MAY 1ST TO SEPTEMBER 30TH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 7-2 (Closing of Streets) of Chapter 7 (Traffic) of the Borough of Manasquan Code is hereby amended and supplemented to establish Sub-section 7-2.3 temporarily closing Riddle Way with the following exceptions:

Riddle Way between 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue shall be temporarily closed from May 1st through September 30th annually. The detour route for traffic shall be along the municipal streets of Main Street and 3rd Avenue. Any and all properties which have residential driveway access between 2nd and 3rd Avenue shall be exempted during the enforcement of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8 (c)(6) and 40:67-16.9, approval by the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation is required as is a Sealed Municipal Engineer's Certification Report pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, N.J.A.C. 15:27-4.2(f), and 16:27-4.3(c)

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency. All other parts of Chapter 7 of the Borough of Manasquan Code not inconsistent herewith are ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and publication.


