

ORDINANCE NO. 2155-14

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND
COMPENSATION OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE
BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan,
County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1. The base compensation or wages to be paid to officers and
employees shall be as follows:

Public Works Superintendent	40,000 to 140,000
Laborer	33,000 to 70,000
Parks Maintenance	33,000 to 70,000
Equipment Operator	33,000 to 75,000
Equipment Operator - Streets	33,000 to 75,000
Water Meter Repairer	33,000 to 70,000
Supervisor, Public Works	33,000 to 85,000
Public Works Repairer	33,000 to 75,000


SECTION 2. All salary provisions, salary related items such as longevity, and
other benefits and stipends of employment, as set forth in any employment agreement
between the Borough of Manasquan and the employees set forth herein are deemed
incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or part of ordinances, which are inconsistent
herewith are repealed but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final
passage and publication as required by law.


NOTICE
