

**BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN
ORDINANCE 2157-14**

**FIXING SALARIES AND
COMPENSATION OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE
BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that:


SECTION 3. All titles noted in parenthesis () are current civil service classifications titles as of the date of the adoption of this ordinance which correspond to Borough positions.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.


NOTICE
